DATA PROTECTION – our approach

You should be aware that a record is kept of all donors and supporters on the basis of the information that you supply, excluding any details which might be deemed sensitive. For accounting and Gift Aid purposes details of donors are retained for 7 years.

This information is recorded in a password protected 'Word' document, held on the Team Google Drive, accessible by the Fundraising Officer only. It is not manipulated, passed to any other organisation, or used for any other purpose beyond the support of the Duddon & Furness Mountain Rescue Team. A copy is occasionally downloaded onto a memory stick, and locked in a safe, to ensure that information is not lost.

If you donate online you will usually be asked to confirm whether you allow 'marketing contact'. If you decline our only contact will be via our annual newsletter, which provides information but not marketing material. If you do not wish to receive the newsletter please let us know.

Unless contact is expressly disallowed our main method of communicating with you will be by letter, which will be individually produced, usually including our newsletter. Following a single donation, or occasional support, we may send you our newsletter on one or two occasions. If you make no further contact we will cease to contact you again (life and standing order supporters excluded). We will not normally contact you by telephone, text or e-mail but may occasionally use e-mail or telephone to resolve a query, to pass on our thanks or when you have offered active support.
